

## ART: COURSE ENROLLMENT (FALL 2009)

### Course Enrollment Periods:

- Enrollment period for Elective and Physical Education classes: July 20 - 29, 2009
- Enrollment period for First-Year Writing Seminars (FWS): July 30 – August 9, 2009

### Art Student Schedule:

All first-year art students enroll in approximately 18 academic credits and one physical education class. In the Fall semester, you are required to enroll in the following classes, totaling 12 academic credits:

- ART 1103: Art Seminar (3 credits)
- ART 1501: Drawing I (3 credits)
- Two of the following art studio courses:
  - ART 1201: Introductory Painting (3 credits)
  - ART 1300: Introduction to Print Media (3 credits)
  - ART 1401: Introductory Sculpture (3 credits)
  - ART 1601: Photography I (3 credits)
  - ART 1701: Electronic Imaging in Art (3 credits)

Required Classes for  
Fall 2009 Semester

The AAP Registrar's Office will pre-enroll you in these required courses by July 1, 2009. You will be able to view your schedule by logging into Student Center at [studentcenter.cornell.edu](http://studentcenter.cornell.edu).

Based on your schedule of required classes, you should select:

- 1 First-Year Writing Seminar (3 credits);
- 1 Art History Elective (3 credits); and
- 1 Physical Education class.

You cannot drop required classes without permission of your advisor, so it is important that you select your remaining classes so that they do not conflict with your required classes. You will enroll in these classes over the summer.

### Course Enrollment Deadlines:

- The AAP Registrar's Office will enroll you in your required classes (ART 1103, 1501, and two of the following art studios – ART 1201, 1300, 1401, 1601, 1701) by July 1, 2009.
- You will enroll in one art history elective and Physical Education from July 20 - 29, 2009 using Student Center at [studentcenter.cornell.edu](http://studentcenter.cornell.edu). Instructions are available online at <http://newstudents.cornell.edu/first-year/courses/>.
