## **Student-Faculty Research in CRP**

## **Independent Study in CRP**

## **How to Enroll in a Student-Faculty Research or an Independent Study in CRP**

1. The student should complete the student information and course information sections of the CRP Independent Study Enrollment Form.
2. The student should complete the independent study information section of the form.
3. The student should bring the complete form to the supervising instructor for approval.
4. The student should bring the form to the appropriate designate for departmental approval.
  - URS Students: advisor and the director of undergraduate studies.
  - GRAD Students: Graduate Field Assistant
5. The student should bring the form to the CRP Department, 106 Sibley to obtain the Class ID number associated with the supervising instructor.
6. After the supervising instructor, the appropriate department approvals AND the CID # have been obtained, the student should bring the form to AAP Academic Services, 235 Sibley Dome for processing.
