

INTENT TO MINOR IN FINE ARTS
Department of Art
College of Architecture, Art, and Planning

The minor in fine arts is an opportunity for students who are not enrolled in the Department of Art and have a serious interest and/or background in studio art to continue their commitment to art at the college level. Students may wish to use the minor in fine arts to augment their academic studies, or ultimately pursue an interdisciplinary field for which studio experience is desirable.

The curriculum for the minor in fine arts totals a minimum of 23 credit hours. All coursework must be completed at Cornell University, and a grade of C or better is required. In addition, any coursework used to fulfill the minor cannot also be used to fulfill specific requirements of the student's major.

Questions regarding the minor can be addressed during AAP Office of Admissions and Academic Services walk-in-hours in 235 Sibley Dome.

The specific course requirements for the minor in fine arts are:

- ART 2103: Introductory Art Seminar (*offered in Fall semester only*)
- 3 art studio courses at the 2000-level
- 2 art studio courses at the 3000-level

Application Process:

Interested students must complete this Intent to Minor form in Fine Arts form in order to receive permission to enroll in ART 2103. Completed forms should be submitted to the AAP Office of Admissions and Academic Services, 235 Sibley Dome. Upon successful completion of all minor requirements, students must submit an Application to Graduate with a Minor in Fine Arts form and an official transcript to the Department of Art, 224 Tjaden Hall, prior to graduation.
