Independent Study in Art

Independent study courses in the Department of Art are offered on the Ithaca campus in the Fall and Spring semesters only. Students enroll for variable credit, for up to a maximum of 4 credits. Independent studio courses of 4 credits taken for a letter grade are applied as elective 3000-level studios. Independent studio courses of fewer than 4 credits and/or taken for an S/U grade are applied as free elective credit only. Enrollment in an independent study requires an approved Independent Study Form.

Independent Study Course Options

- ART 3091 Directed Readings in Art
- ART 3092 Independent Studio in Art
- ART 3093 Directed Research in Art

Eligibility requirements for enrolling in an independent study (independent studio, directed readings, directed research)*:

- Successful completion of the 2000-level and one 3000-level studio in the studio practice area;
- A cumulative GPA of 2.7 or better required; and
- Enrollment in Ithaca during the Fall or Spring Semester

The above information must be verified by AAP Academic Services on an Art Independent Study Enrollment Form **prior** to enrollment.

** Out-of-department students may be exempt from these requirements at the discretion of the supervising professor.*

How to Enroll in an Independent Study in Art

1. The student should complete the student information and course information sections of the Art Independent Study Enrollment Form.
2. The student should complete the independent study information section of the form and attach an abstract.
3. The student should bring the complete form, including abstract, to the supervising instructor for approval.
4. The student should bring the form to AAP Academic Services, 235 Sibley Dome, for verification of eligibility requirements.
6. After the supervising instructor AND the AAP Academic Services office have approved the independent study, the form and abstract should be brought to the Art Department, 224 Tjaden Hall, for department chair approval.
7. The approved form and abstract should be submitted to AAP Academic Services, 235 Sibley Dome, for processing.
